

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 16-  
28 THAT ENACTED THE POLICY FOR CITIZENRY  
COMMITTEE**

The Petersburg City Council, by the authority vested in them, hereby approves the policy for Citizenry Committee; and

The Committee shall be comprised of seven citizens, one from each Ward. The selection of the citizens will be by the members of Council. The citizen shall be a registered voter in the Ward they are representing. They will serve from the time they are appointed until December 31, 2016. The Committee at that time will be dissolved; and

The City Attorney will be a representative on the Committee, as legal research and guidance will be necessary to complete the work of the Committee. The City Attorney will be responsible for recording the minutes of any meeting, and drafting the final recommendations of the Committee. The Committee shall select their Chair and Vice-Chair from the selected citizens; and

The Committee will conduct a minimum of two (2) public meetings, and will provide a final report to City Council by November 2, 2016. The final report will contain the final recommendations of the Committee. The Committee will start no sooner than September 1, 2016.

The City Council will be responsible for the final decision on the recommendations. The City Council will also assess the current financial and situational factors relating to the final recommendations, and decide either to approve a set of modifications to the current City Charter, or to authorize the dissolution of the City Charter and request that the City return to Town status.
